Baton Rouge - Millwright Tool List:

1st Year Apprentice

Toolbox with lock
Ball peen hammer (heavy)
Putty knife
Gasket scraper
10' or 12' Tape measure
2 Adjustable crescent wrenches- 8" & 12"
6" and/or 10" Locking vise grip pliers
4½" or 7" Needle nose pliers
Side cutter pliers
9½" or 10" Channel lock pliers
#2 Crosshead screwdriver
Phillips screwdriver
0 to 1" Micrometer
Flathead screwdrivers- ¼" & 3/8"

2nd Year Apprentice

Tin Snips
6½" Snap ring pliers
Drift pin aligning bar
Drive Ratchets- 3/8" & ½"
16" Minimum length pry bar
Folding feeler gauge set-long blade
Folding feeler gauge set-short blade
Hack saw with extra blades
Allen wrench set- short & long lengths
Combination set wrenches- 3/8" to 1 ¼"
½" Drive socket set- short & deep to 1¼" & U-Joint
3/8" Drive socket set- short & deep to 7/8" & U-Joint

3rd Year Apprentice

Plumb bob
Drill point gauge
Small jack screws
Dial caliper- 6" or 12"
Magnetic base indicator holder
2 Indicator chain clamps
Precision level- Starrett 98- 6"
Cold chisels- 1 small & 1 large
Chalk line- retractable 100' in chalk box
Bevel protractor- square head & center head
2 Dial indicator sets with holders & spiders
Combination square set with 12" grooved ruled blade
Dividers- spring type in 3", 4", 6" 8", 10", & 12" lengths

4th Year Apprentice

Mirror & magnet with telescoping handles
Wedges- non-spark, non-abrasive, Brass/Copper
6" steel scale ruled by 64^{ths}
Torpedo level
Scribe- steel, carbide, etc.
